What is cyberbullying?


There is no single definition of bullying and cyberbullying agreed upon internationally and at European level.

What is it so important?

- -1/3 children has been a victim of cyberbullying
- -Nearly half of suicides among 10 to 14 year olds are due to bullying
- 1 in 7 teachers is a victim of cyberbullying
